PERMIT SUBMISSION GUIDE



EXTERIOR & SITE LIGHTING

- 1. Building Permit Application For any new light(s) around buildings, in parking lots, etc., including poles and bases (not required for lighting attached to building)
- 2. PA Architect's/Engineer's signed and sealed plans noting, including but not limited to, location, materials, concrete, etc.
- 3. Electrical Permit Application
- 4. PA Architect's/Engineer's signed and sealed electrical plans approved by the Electrical Underwriter noting, including but not limited to, all underground and/or overhead wiring, connections, lumens, etc. Note: Electrical Underwriter who approves the plans must also perform the inspections
- 5. Cut Sheets for all proposed lighting
- 6. Grading Permit Application may be required based on the extent of the project
- 7. Contractor Registration Forms and Certificates of Insurance
- 8. Copies of all Signed Contracts and Scopes of Work for all Contractors
- 9. PDF/Digital copy of all plan submissions
- 10. Permit Application Fees will be determined upon receipt of the above
- 11. Note: Additional fees will be charged for third-party plan review, as well as review by Upper Dublin Township's lighting consultant
 - All applications must be fully completed with email addresses for both the property owner, contractor, engineer, etc. and signed by the applicant – Incomplete or unsigned applications will not be accepted
 - Permit Fees are due upon submission of application
 - It takes approximately 15 business days for residential / 30 business days for commercial permit applications to be reviewed and, if approved, issued. No work may commence until permit has been issued or Late Fees will be charged per Code.
