Bids were received and publicly opened on Friday, May 19, 2023, for the Public Work Renovation – Phase II Project. A mandatory pre-bid meeting was attended by a total of 18 interested contractors with a total of 15 bids received. A copy of the Bid Tabulations are attached for your reference.

The bids were reviewed by the appropriate administrative and supervisory personnel, and the recommendation of the award is based upon the lowest priced, responsible bidders meeting the requirements of the Contract Documents.

Additionally, DEI has contacted select references for each prime contract. The summary of reference checks is attached for your review.

The bidding climate is busy with a number of projects bidding concurrently with this Project. However, we were able to obtain competitive bids and the sum of the overall bids for the Prime Contracts, are below the budget. The budget also includes construction contingency. We are in the process of re-allocating scope and costs to the next project phase to properly account for the changes made to make the project and costs as efficient as possible. The low bidders are as follows:
