Alison,

I have the following comments regarding the Township Building Land Development plans:

- 1. 212.15.B: The proper ultimate right-of-way along Loch Alsh Avenue is 40 feet from centerline, the current plan depicts approximately 36 feet from centerline.
- 2. 212.17.D: 20-foot separation is required from parking spaces adjacent to building walls.
- 3. 212.17.H: The minimum radius of curb is 5 feet, there are a couple places where 2.5' feet is in the design and requires revision.
- 4. 212.18: The existing sidewalk, at 3' wide, should be replaced with 5' wide sidewalk to match the other proposed sidewalk.
- 5. 212.25.A.5: Approval of the plans from Montgomery County Conservation District is required.
- 6. 212.32: The landscape plan should depict street trees and a softening buffer in accordance with the landscape section requirements.
- 7. Applicant should confirm the signature blocks for the Township and County are current and will be acceptable.
- 8. Township Traffic Engineer should review and confirm if the proposed access locations are suitable for the intended use.
- 9. A crosswalk to the High School should be included along the frontage.
