Re: 2024 Mill and Overlay Resurfacing Program

## Dear Resident:

This letter is to notify you that the Township's portion of the 2024 milling and paving program is scheduled to begin on August 5, 2024. The work will be done by the Township Public Works crew. The schedule <u>is</u> <u>dependent on weather and equipment operations</u>. Temporary "No Parking" signs will be posted by the Township Highway Department at least one day before the work is done.

The current detailed schedule of this work can be found on the Township website. This schedule will be updated on a daily basis. Please check the web page often to remain current on the schedule.

## The streets to be done are as follows:

Although work may not be done on your particular street until later in the day, the contractor usually begins work at 7:00 AM. You are strongly encouraged to be sure that automobiles are moved out of your driveway and off your street before this time.

During the milling process (whereby the existing blacktop is removed from the street), you will be able to get cars into and out of your driveway with relatively short notice, except when the milling equipment is working directly in front of your property. In that case, you may have to wait up to thirty (30) minutes before being able to move your car. During the paving process, adequate time (usually a few hours) must be allowed for the new blacktop to be properly compacted and cooled before traffic can drive on it. This will prevent damage to both the new street surface and to your car's finish/tires. It is also encouraged to not make sharp turns into and out of your driveway for a few days after paving to prevent the appearance of tire marks on the new roadway.

The milling contractor and the Township crew will do everything possible to reduce the inconvenience to our residents during this paving project. Your patience and cooperation are appreciated. The milling/paving process should not have to be repeated on your street for approximately twenty to thirty (20-30) years, although the road will be resurfaced every seven to ten (7-10) years with a thin surface treatment in order to prevent road deterioration.
